

Outline of the 46th Fukuoka City Art Competition

Purpose

The organizers promote citizen creativeness in every field of the arts and provide opportunities to express their achievements and appreciate them, and by doing so, the organizers attempt to promote the art activities of the citizens.

Date

March 13 (Tues) - March 25 (Sun), 2012 (closed on Monday)

1st half period: March 13 (Tues) - March 18 (Sun), 6 days (Japanese-style painting, Calligraphy, Photography, Design)

2nd half period: March 20 (Tues) - March 25 (Sun), 6 days (Western-style painting, Sculpture, Applied Art)

Venue

Fukuoka Art Museum (1-6 Ohori Park, Chuo-ku, Fukuoka City)

Specifications for Applying for Entry

Japanese-style painting: All artworks must be temporarily framed. (The frame must be simple in unicolor and its thickness must be within 7 cm). Maximum size must be 162.1 cm x 162.1 cm. Glass and acrylic are not acceptable. Matting is acceptable only for Calligraphy (the width of frame must be within 8 cm).

Western-style painting: All works must be temporarily framed. (The frame must be simple in unicolor and its thickness must be within 7 cm.) For the protection of the work, the frame must be more than 1 cm further protecting from the painting. (without glass) Matting is permitted (its width must be within 8 cm) for watercolor, pastel and prints. The size must be within 162.1 cm x 162.1 cm for oil painting, watercolor, pastel and prints.

Sculpture: Must be within the 250 cm x 200 cm x 200 cm in size, and 750 kg in weight. A work must be securely positioned so that it is mobile as well as ready to exhibit.

Applied Arts: The framed work (glass is not acceptable) must be within 150 cm in width. However, folding screens must be within 182 cm in width. The ones requiring wall hanging must be within 20 kg in weight. It must be securely positioned so that it is mobile as well as ready for exhibition.

Calligraphy: It must be framed (without glass) and its weight must be within 15 kg. The scroll is not acceptable. The finished dimensions must be within: A) 242 cm high x 61 cm wide, B) 79 cm high x 182 cm wide (height and width are reversible), C) 91 cm high x 121 cm wide. In case of seal engraving, the original plate is not needed. The completed dimensions must be within 40 cm high x 30 cm wide. On the back of the work, you must paste the written calligraphy text in print.

Photography: A single photograph must be 45.7 cm x 55.9 cm. It must be treated with a matted wooden panel within 75 cm x 60 cm x 3.5 cm (thick) in size. A group of photographs must be within 100 cm x 70 cm x 3.5 cm (thick) on a paper-matted wooden panel (its height and width are reversible) and its each photo must be more than 25.4 cm x 30.5 cm in size. Each panel shall be counted as one work. The framing and dry mount are not acceptable.

Design: The theme is non-specified; however, it must be a request to the Fukuoka City how you would like the city to be; or, any aspects of Fukuoka you would like to preserve, or a sightseeing events, or about people as well as global environmental issues, or nuclear problems, such public issues as in a form of poster and illustration (stating a particular brand name is not acceptable). It must be within 103 cm x 72.8 cm in size attached on a plywood panel or it must be framed if pasted on a styrene foam panel with its surface protected with an acrylic piece, (except if the surface is treated with mat coating.) Its thickness must be within 3 cm and the length and width are reversible. (framing is not acceptable)

Artwork for Entry: Art works must be made by him/herself and must be not yet released in public exhibitions.

The Number of Artwork for Entry: The number of work is limited to 2 works per person in each category and for those who are making entry of two works, please transport them at the same time.

Application Fee: An application fee is 2,500yen per work. Please pay at the time of transporting your work to the museum.

Application Requirements: At the time of submitting an application, you must be living in the Fukuoka City area, or commuting of workers or students. Elementary school students and under are not eligible. Intended for the people who live in the areas below:

Non-acceptance: We will not accept any applicants who do not meet the guidelines as set forth in this outline.

Copyrights: The Organizers hold the right to take photographs of works exhibited for publishing in catalog. The Organizers will grant permission to the press and art publications concerned, to publicize the works exhibited only when it is considered necessary for promotion of the exhibition.

Place: Eastside loading/unloading entrance, Fukuoka Art Museum

Carrying out: Non-selected work - March 13 (Tues) - 18 (Sun), March 20 (Tues) - 25 (Sun) 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Exhibited work for the 1st half period: March 20 (Tues) - 25 (Sun), March 29(Thu) - April 1(Sun) 10:00 am - 5:00pm
Exhibited work for the 2nd half period: March 29 (Tues) - April 1 (Sun) 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Place: Eastside loading/unloading entrance
*You need to present your receipt that was given to you at the time of entry in return for your work.
*If your work is not picked up by April 2, it shall be discarded accordingly by the Organizers.

Safety and Security of Artwork:

The Organizers shall treat the exhibits with utmost efforts for safety and security; however, the Organizers shall not be responsible for any damage to works caused by a natural disaster or other circumstances that are beyond human control nor due to materials used that are generally considered to have been fragile ones.

Expenses and Tools for: Bringing In and Out Artwork:

All the expenses of bringing in and out work are borne by you. Please prepare to bring all the necessary tools for this occasion.

The commendation ceremony will take place at the Fukuoka Art Museum Auditorium on March 18 (Sun), 2012.

Gallery Talks

On March 18 and 25, at 3:00pm, gallery talks explaining and commenting on the exhibits shall be held in each gallery by the judges. Participation is free of charge (a gallery ticket is needed).
